How do I register for 2022 N.C. Dental Opioid Update Course online?

What are the dates and locations for the 2022 N.C. Dental Opioid Update Course?

All courses will be taught using Zoom virtual platform. To print a copy of the courses with dates, click “Print Course Dates Via Zoom”.

Do I have to take an Opioid course each year?

Yes, or until the N.C. State Legislature makes changes to the General Statute in the law. The STOP Act, which requires a dentist to take at least one hour of continuing education in opioids and prescription writing each year for dental license renewal, is a N.C. Legislature requirement and was not instigated by our NC State Board of Dental Examiners. In order for the opioid course requirement to be changed or dropped, it would have to be a ruling from the N.C. Legislature.

How do I receive my CE certificate for completing the N.C. Dental Opioid Update Course?

You will be sent an email to complete a short post-test immediately after the course. After completing the post-test, you will be sent another email within 2 weeks that will allow you to download your certificate.

Do I have to send a copy of the CE Certificate I receive at this course each year to the North Carolina State Board of Dental Examiners?
